Nationwide Membership Program

The Bedford Area Family YMCA participates in the Nationwide Membership Program and honors visiting YMCA members in good standing. Nationwide Members are afforded the full and unrestricted use of our premises and facilities at no charge however, Nationwide Members must use their home YMCA at least 51% of the time. To be eligible as a Nationwide Member, your home YMCA must be participating in the Nationwide Membership Program and you must be a member in good standing with your home YMCA. Nationwide Members may not bring guests who would not otherwise be eligible as a Nationwide Member. Nationwide Members will be responsible for any damages incurred to the premises, facilities, furnishings, equipment or other property of the Bedford Area Family YMCA as a result.

Guest Policy

Bedford Area Family YMCA welcomes first time visitors to be our guest one time per year at no charge. All guests are required to follow all Bedford Area Family YMCA Rules of Conduct and rules addressing the use of the facilities. Guests will be responsible for any damages incurred to the premises, facilities, furnishings, equipment or other property of the Bedford Area Family YMCA as a result.

Day Pass Guest Policy

We allow guests to visit the Bedford Area YMCA by purchasing a Day Pass. Day Passes are \$15 per day for adults and \$8 per day for youth 18 and under and seniors over 55. All guests are required to follow all Bedford Area Family YMCA Rules of Conduct and rules addressing the use of the facilities. Guests will be responsible for any damages incurred to the premises, facilities, furnishings, equipment or other property of the Bedford Area Family YMCA as a result.

Program Members

These are guests who have signed up for specific YMCA programs. These individuals have unlimited visits for their specific program.

Code of Conduct

The Bedford Area Family YMCA is a charitable, not-for-profit membership organization. I understand the Y will have no liability or responsibility for any personal injuries, or loss or damage to personal property, sustained by the member while using the Y facilities. Membership card/s must be presented to use the facility. Any member who loans their membership card to another individual will be subject to loss of membership privileges.

1. The Bedford Area Family YMCA is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all members and guests. To promote safety and comfort for all, we expect individuals to act appropriately at all times when they are in our facility or participating in our programs
2. We expect persons using the Bedford Area Family YMCA to behave in a mature and responsible way, and to respect the rights and dignity of others. Our Code of Conduct does not permit language or any action that can hurt or frighten another person, or that falls below a generally accepted standard of conduct
3. Prohibited actions specifically include:
 - Angry or vulgar language; includes swearing, name-calling or shouting
 - Inappropriate attire. Appropriate attire must be worn at all times
 - Physical contact with another person in any angry or threatening way or any unwanted contact
 - Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual contact with another person
 - Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language or any menacing behavior
 - Theft or behavior that results in the destruction of property
 - Carrying or concealing any weapons or devices or objects that may be used as weapons
 - Using or possessing illegal substance or alcohol on Bedford Area Family YMCA sponsored programs
 - Any other conduct of any inappropriate, threatening or offensive nature
4. Loitering is not permitted in or outside the Bedford Area Family YMCA
5. Smoking is not permitted in or outside the Bedford Area Family YMCA. The Bedford Area Family YMCA and its property is a smoke-free environment
6. Members and guests are encouraged to be responsible for their personal comfort and safety, and to ask any person whose behavior threatens their safety or comfort to refrain from such conduct. If a member or guest feels uncomfortable in confronting the person directly, they should report the behavior to a staff person Bedford Y staff members are eager to be of assistance. Members and guests should not hesitate to notify a staff member if assistance is needed
7. In order to be able to carry out these policies, members and guests are required to identify themselves to staff when asked

The Executive Director will investigate all reported incidents. Suspension or termination of Y membership privileges may result from a determination by the Executive Director, and/or Board of Directors, if in their discretion a violation of the Bedford Area Family YMCA Code of Conduct has occurred.
